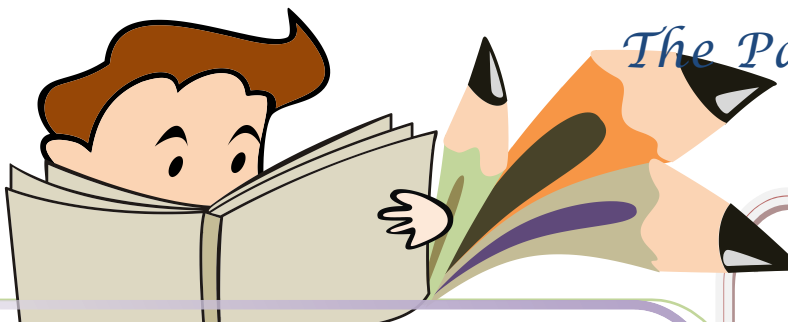

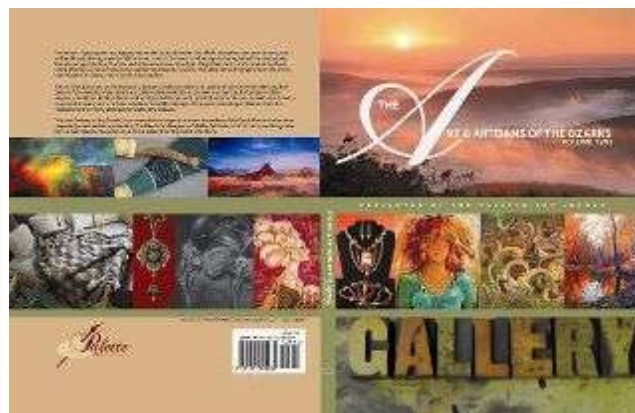

announced a twenty million dollar grant from Walmart to cover admission fees for all visitors. Prior to the grant, a \$10 admission fee was being considered for adults.

"The Northwest Arkansas community is so important to us -- it's where our associates live, work and play," said Walmart president and CEO Mike Duke. "We are excited about the cultural opportunities Crystal Bridges is bringing to our area and even more excited that our families, friends and neighbors will experience it at no cost."

"One of the greatest challenges for museums today is finding ways to remove barriers to community participation, including admission charges," said Don Bacigalupi, Crystal Bridges executive director.
